On 29 March 2012, the Whadjuk Working Party meeting was presented with a proposal for a coastal heritage walk trail by officers of the Rottnest Island Authority.

The Whadjuk Working Party members extend appreciation to the Rottnest Island Authority for consulting with the Working Party.

In response, the Whadjuk Working Party gave 'in principle' support for the proposed coastal heritage walk trail.

During the presentation there was support for the Rottnest Island Authority to provide an onsite visit to Rottnest Island for members of the Working Party to assess the impact of the proposal. SWALSC will liaise with the Rottnest Island Authority to make arrangements for the visit.

The Working Party also looks forward to ongoing consultation and engagement on the development of the proposal, including input into interpretative signage and opportunities for future employment and training for Whadjuk People.
