



## Request to Import Flora

In accordance with RIA's Rottneest Island Regulations 1988 Regulation 41B (2) any importation of flora on Rottneest Island requires the approval of the Rottneest Island Authority.

As per Section 5.1 the Biosecurity – Flora Importation policy, it is the Importer's responsibility to ensure that the flora supplier engaged is suitably certified.

Understand as per Section 5.2 of the Biosecurity – Importation of Flora Guidelines, that soil or flora not appropriately demonstrated to be weed, pest, disease and pathogen free, will either be disposed of or sent back to the mainland at the contractor's cost.
